CELEBRATE THE PAST:

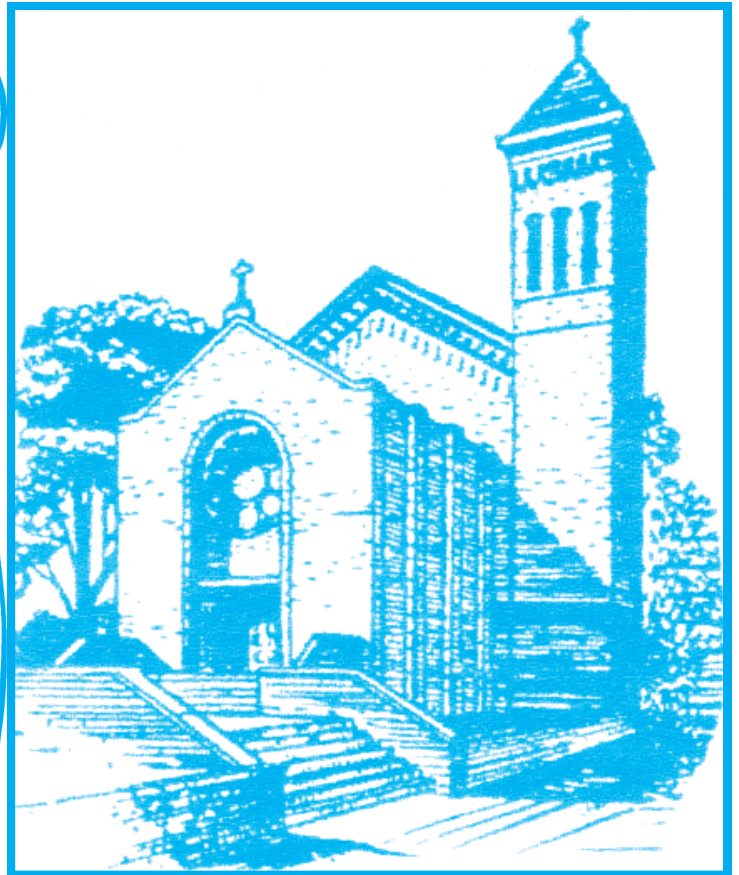
By examining, studying and capturing the history of the men and women, religious and lay, who established, nurtured and built it and all of its facets;

POSTURE AT MASS: There has been much confusion over the proper posture during Mass. According to Bishop Hubbard's directive, the congregation should stand up after the priest says "Pray brethren that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the Almighty Father." The congregation should kneel after the congregation says "Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts.....Hosanna in the highest." The congregation should stand after the priest says "At the Savior's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say Our Father... The congregation should **remain standing** until after Communion when they can either sit or kneel. While other parishes may not comply with the Bishop's directive, the Bishop's directive will be followed at St. Michael's.
