A CLARIFICATION: Recent articles in the Troy Record, Albany Times Union, and The Evangelist regarding the sale of St. Rita's Church have left many people with the wrong impression on the proceeds of this sale. It is true that the property sold for \$595,000. However, all of that money did not come to Holy Trinity as the successor parish, as was stated in the articles. With the sale of any property of a closed parish, any money owed to the diocese is paid first. After all outstanding debts are paid and all costs associated with the sale are satisfied, the balance is then given to the successor parish. The following is a breakdown of the disbursement of the proceeds from the sale of St. Rita's: Property Transfer Fees \$68,129.76, Diocesan Assessment Arrears \$60,679.60, Outstanding Bills \$2,238.17, Diocesan Loan Principal 281,000.00, Diocesan Loan Interest \$2,051.39, for a Total Outstanding Debt of \$414,098.92. The remaining balance, 180,901.08, was divided between Holy Trinity and St. Michael's. (By agreement, the proceeds from the properties of all the closed parishes, after payment of all fees and debts will be divided equally between the two parishes.) Each parish received \$90,450.54. As each church property is sold, you will receive a full accounting of the transaction. In the meantime, please call me at 237-2973 if you have any questions. - **Father Becker**
