BULLETIN DEADLINE: The deadline for information (in writing) to be included in the bulletin is Monday by noon.

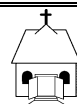


To stay healthy this flu season, take these everyday steps to protect your health. Cover your nose & mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and throw the tissue in the trash after you use it. Wash your hands often with soap & water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way. Try to avoid close contact with sick people. Stay home if you are sick until at least 24 hours after you no longer have a fever (100°F or 37.8°C) or signs of a fever (without the use of a fever-reducing medicine, such as Tylenol®). Follow public health advice regarding school closures, avoiding crowds & other social distancing measures.

Last year's pageant was very successful & enjoyable for both the children & the parishioners. Rehearsals will begin November 29th after the 9am Mass.
