The cost of the dinner is \$10 for members & \$11 for guests and will be collected at the door only. Please bring a grab bag (value \$5) which will be distributed by Santa. This will be a very enjoyable time to start the Christmas season, so please plan on attending.



To stay healthy this flu season, take these everyday steps to protect your health. Cover your nose & mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and throw the tissue in the trash after you use it. Wash your hands often with soap & water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way. Try to avoid close contact with sick people. Stay home if you are sick until at least 24 hours after you no longer have a fever (100°F or 37.8°C) or signs of a fever (without the use of a fever-reducing medicine, such as Tylenol®). Follow public health advice regarding school closures, avoiding crowds & other social distancing measures.
