CEMETERY RULES

PERMITTED:

- Artificial floral pieces in monument areas of the cemetery only
- Potted plants <u>on the base</u> of the monument
- Flags will be allowed on graves sites for one month (30 days) following Memorial Day
- Wreaths and vases on graves are allowed during Christmas season only
- Flush Markers: All Flush Markers shall be set so that the top is flush or level with the ground. This includes Family and Military Markers

NOT PERMITTED:

- The planting of tress, shrubs or flowers on any lot or grave. Existing trees or shrubs that are not maintained or are overgrown will be removed by the cemetery at the owner's expense. Existing planted flowers are to be removed by the owner or will be removed by the cemetery at the owner's expense.
- Urns and flower boxes
- Glass items, statues and plastic ornaments
- Stone, marble or wood chips

GENERAL CLEAN-UP:

- General clean-up will be performed in April and November of each year
- Prior to general clean-up, lot holders are responsible for removing decorations they wish to save
- Each lot owner is responsible for the removal and disposal of all unwanted floral arrangements, etc. Such items should <u>not</u> be placed near the garage.

Note: These are the same rules used by all of the Albany Diocesan Cemeteries
